

Fall Protection Training

OSHA requires that employers provide training for each employee that may be exposed to a fall hazard. Falls are a leading cause of construction related deaths each year and an average of over 4,000 OSHA Citations are issued to employers each year for the lack of protecting employees from a fall. Achieving fall protection calls for basic training for employees, constant vigilance from supervisors, and the use of protection systems.

Course Description:

At Safety Equipped, Inc., we believe that the best way to be certain that a fall does not occur is through employee fall hazard awareness and taking the steps to prevent a fall from occurring at all.


